



# MIRACLES OF JESUS

## Week #6: Jesus Heals the Centurion's Servant

Matthew 8:5-13 – “ When he had entered Capernaum, a centurion came forward to him, appealing to him, <sup>6</sup>“Lord, my servant is lying paralyzed at home, suffering terribly.” <sup>7</sup> And he said to him, “I will come and heal him.” <sup>8</sup> But the centurion replied, “Lord, I am not worthy to have you come under my roof, but only say the word, and my servant will be healed. <sup>9</sup> For I too am a man under authority, with soldiers under me. And I say to one, ‘Go,’ and he goes, and to another, ‘Come,’ and he comes, and to my servant, ‘Do this,’ and he does it.” <sup>10</sup> When Jesus heard this, he marveled and said to those who followed him, “Truly, I tell you, with no one in Israel have I found such faith. <sup>11</sup> I tell you, many will come from east and west and recline at table with Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob in the kingdom of heaven, <sup>12</sup> while the sons of the kingdom will be thrown into the outer darkness. In that place there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth.” <sup>13</sup> And to the centurion Jesus said, “Go; let it be done for you as you have believed.” And the servant was healed at that very moment.”

1. Welcome / introductions

3. Read the passage above:
  - a. “What does this miracle tell us about Jesus?”
  - b. “What does this miracle tell us about the relationship between Jesus and those who witnessed the miracle?”
  - c. What impact did this miracle have on those witnesses?
  - d. “How does this miracle speak to your current situation?”
4. Read the passage together one more time:
  - a. “How can we pray for each other this week?”
  - b. “How can we support each other this week?”
5. Close meeting in prayer (specifically discussing what was shared in last question)
